

INTD course approval process for the fall 2007 semester
September 25, 2007

For the spring 2008 semester, it is expected that the INTD C&CC will be reformed to consist of faculty representatives of each school and college appointed by the Dean of each school and college and, during the fall 2007 semester, approvals of new INTD courses will be kept to the minimum. Where possible, the making of wholly new INTD course precedents will be deferred until a new INTD Courses Committee is constituted in spring 2008. Therefore, Dr. Lamb, Director of IISP and the INTD courses administrator, has proposed, and INTD C&CC has accepted on September 17, 2007, the following arrangements

INTD Course Policy – Fall 2007 (applicable for courses to be offered Intersession and Spring 2008)

- All INTD courses with permanent numbers will continue as approved; no substantive changes will be considered or made.
- All INTD experimental courses approved by INTD C&CC may continue to be offered (as approved) in the 2007/8 academic year. No revised proposals will be required for a Spring 2008 offering, but IISP will ask course instructors to update previous proposal documents before scheduling requests.
- All new INTD 193/197/293/299 independent study and individual study abroad approvals will continue to require the approval of the IISP Director.
- Existing INTD new course proposals that have not yet received Senate approval will continue to be supported administratively by IISP and, where necessary, reviewed by INTD C&CC.
- No other new INTD course proposals – permanent or experimental – will be considered in Fall 2007.
- Entirely new experimental INTD course proposals should seek a departmental designation if instructors intend that they would be offered in Spring 2008.
